



Issuance of the Union Supreme Court: the Key Performance in 2020 and

Priority Actions for 2021

Nay Pyi Taw, 17 February 2021- The Supreme Court of the Union today issues the key performance in 2020 and priority actions for 2021.

The Key Performance in 2020

- Improving clearance rate of cases at the different levels of court up to 92.2% while the cases were postponed by the Covid-19 outbreak
- Expanding the implementation of National Case Management program (NCMP) in 25 District Courts and 109 Township Courts
- Expanding the implementation of Court-led Mediation Pilot Program in 6 Township Courts within Dekkhina District
- Expanding coverage of special interview rooms and video conferencing facilities in 16 District Courts
- Issuing the Insolvency Rules
- Drafting and submitting the Bill amending the Civil Procedure Code for mediation in civil suits
- Launching the Ruling Content Management System (RCMS)
- Launching the Commercial Judgment System (CJS)
- Signing the Memorandum of Guidance as to Enforcement of Money Judgments between the Supreme Court of the Union and Singapore Supreme Court
- Issuing the guidance on use of technology for criminal cases and juvenile cases in COVID-19 prevention and controlling time
- Making hearing and ordering the appellate and revisional cases, and conferring the Advocateship certificate via video conferencing

Priority Actions for 2021

- Expand the implementation of National Case Management program in 22 District Courts and 104 Township Courts to solve the cases fairly and efficiently in accordance with law
- Reduce the postponement rate and decide the cases within time standard under the Case Management Procedures
- Establish the Special Division in court for Intellectual Property Rights cases
- Expand the Pilot Program of the Court-led Mediation in Civil Suits in all Courts of Mandalay and Yangon Regions
- Expand coverage of special interview rooms and video conferencing facilities in courts for witness protection
- Enhance the cooperation in juvenile justice
